Available for Public Review and Comment until October 20, 2014

Pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 2706(c)(5) and 15 C. F.R. 990.55

Notice is hereby given that a Draft Primary Restoration Plan and Environmental Assessment (Draft PRP/EA) for the April 27, 2006, the T/V MARGARA Incident is available for public review and comment for a period of 30 days. This document has been prepared by the state and federal natural resource trustee agencies listed above (the "Trustees"). The T/V MARGARA Incident involved the grounding of a 228-m (748-ft) oil tanker carrying over 300,000 barrels of #6 fuel oil in coral reef habitat three miles south of Tallaboa, Puerto Rico. Although the vessel was refloated and removed the day after the grounding without discharging any oil, the Incident injured and destroyed coral species and impacted the coral reef structure and ecosystem across an estimated eight acres of coral reef habitat. Emergency restoration actions undertaken at the site between 2006 and 2008 could not address all physical injuries or conditions at the site caused by the Incident. The Draft PRP/EA was developed by the Trustees and identifies the additional actions the Trustees are proposing to undertake at the site in order to restore lost topographic complexity and address site conditions that are continuing to impede natural recovery processes at site.

An additional opportunity for public review will be provided if public comments on this Draft PRP/EA result in significant changes to the restoration actions proposed herein.

The Draft PRP/EA was developed in accordance with the Trustees' authorities under the Oil Pollution Act (OPA), 33 U.S.C. § 2701 *et seq.*, and other applicable federal laws. The Puerto Rico Department of Natural And Environmental Resources is also acting pursuant to Law 147 of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
